**MANORHAMILTON – 5.00 P.M.**

Mr. John Mc Guinness, Director of Services provided an overview of the Roads Programme, while Mr. Shay O' Connor, Senior Engineer discussed each of the subheadings for Manorhamilton Area in detail.

The members accepted the Road Works Scheme as presented.

The Councillors requested that the list of costed LIS Schemes be included with the current list of LIS Schemes

The councillors also requested that an advert be placed on local radio reminding farmers of their obligations to maintain roadside hedges before 1<sup>st</sup> March.

Councillor Ferguson requested that contact be made once again with Donegal County Council to see if issue of Lennox Bridge could be progressed.

It was suggested that a STOP sign be placed on all roads beside the pedestrian crossing in Manorhamilton.

**DROMAHAIRE AREA - 6.00pm.**

Mr. John McGuinness gave an overview of the programme while Mr. Shay O'Connor, Senior Engineer made a detailed presentation of the sub headings for the Dromahaire area.

The members accepted the Road Works Scheme as presented.

Councillor McTernan confirmed the local Sergeant in Dromahaire is not happy with the proposed one-way system for the town.

Councillor McGloin & Councillor Dolan requested that the road to Department office in Drumshanbo get priority going forward.

All the councillors made reference to the continuous flooding at Shriff on the Lough Gill Road.

Councillor McTernan indicated that there were too many signs in Dromahaire, while Councillor McGloin indicated that more signage required at Kilclare.

Councillor Bohan raised the issue of casual workers. John McGuinness replied that there may be a skills deficit in certain areas but the level of grants would suggest limited if any casual workers could be employed in 2009.
