The country is now divided into 3 regions in terms of waste planning and all three Draft Regional Plans were launched nationally on that date. The public consultation period for all three plans commenced on the 18th of November and will run until the 30th of January 2015. Following the public consultation, submissions will be considered and the final plan will be published by the end of Quarter 1 2015.

The Connacht Ulster Waste Region encompasses the following local authorities: Cavan County Council, Donegal County Council, Galway County Council, Galway City Council, Leitrim County Council, Mayo County Council, Monaghan County Council, Roscommon County Council and Sligo County Council.
