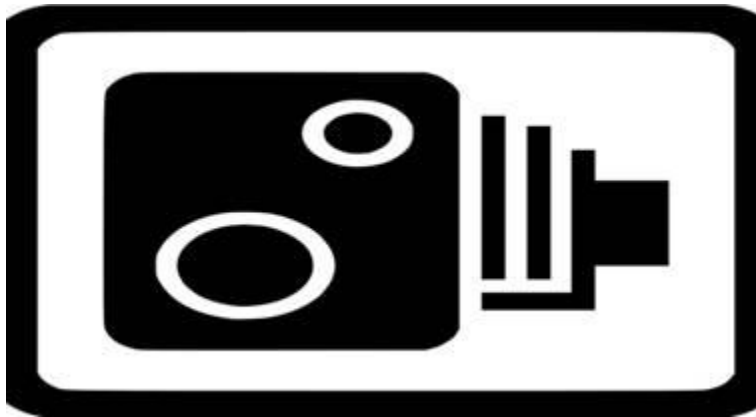


## Leitrim County Council – Road Safety Office

### New Garda Speed Enforcement Zones – Effective since 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2020

Leitrim County Council Road Safety Office wishes to remind the public that **New Go Safe Enforcement Zones have been added to the list of existing Go Safe Enforcement Zones and these new Zones became effective on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2020.** Countrywide a total of 903 new Zones have been added, 575 have been removed and there will now be a total of 1,322 Safety Camera Zones Nationwide. Leitrim have 8 new Zones added to the existing Zones making a total of 13 such Zones in County Leitrim from 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2020. All Safety Camera Zones are available to view on the Garda Website.

Please note that the Information sign below will NOT be in use at the new locations.
